A Groundworker prepares the land ready for building. The main duties of a groundworker involve drainage, concreting, kerbing and flagging (lying kerbs as flag stones). The role of a Groundworker is to assist with the creation RC Frame and all forms of infrastructure applicable.

The Ground Worker shall be responsible for:

- Undertaking ground working marking out excavation of foundations, structures, and placing of concrete
- Assist in drainage operations excavation of trench, laying pipes, backfilling, construction of manholes
- Assist in Form working operations erecting and dismantling shuttering
- Undertake concreting placing and finishing concrete for foundation and structures
- Assist in road construction excavation, placing and compaction of hardcore, preparation for surfacing
- Assist with the laying of kerbs and paving
- Operating items of equipment such as drills, breakers, pumps, and compressor.
