

Information on the Membership of the Governing Body of Camden School for Girls 2025-26

The Governing Body was re-constituted on 1 September 2015, and this information was ratified on 14 October 2015

It is important that governors and staff act impartially and are seen to act impartially. In May 1996 the Nolan Committee published a report on standards in public life as applicable to local public spending bodies. The report identified seven principles which should be applied in public life. These are selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership. One important means by which a self-governing school demonstrates that it is applying these principles is by maintaining detailed information including a register of business, pecuniary and material interests.

The governing body and school staff have a responsibility to avoid any conflict between their business and personal interests and affairs and the interests of the school. A register of business, pecuniary and material interests must be maintained and made readily accessible for all governors, including staff governors and the headteacher. This will help the governing body to be transparent and meet the requirements for withdrawal from meetings as prescribed by law.
