## Examination Results Booklet 2018

We are delighted to announce that our students achieved outstanding results in the GCSE and A Level examinations. The examination success of all students demonstrates their hard work and determination whatever grades they achieve.

### GCSE & Equivalent Results

**108** year 11 students were entered for GCSE and equivalent qualifications at Camden School for Girls. They achieved an average of **10** GCSEs or equivalents per student.

**38** students achieved A\* - A / 9 - 7 grades in eight or more Full Course GCSEs, **16** of whom achieved A\* / 9 - 8 grades in eight or more Full Course GCSEs.

**2** students achieved a total of nine grade 9s!

## Advanced Level Exam Results

Students at Camden School for Girls have achieved an excellent set of A level examination results and have, once again, out-performed students nationally by a very significant margin.

**239** year 13 students and **15** year 12 students sat **722** A levels in 2018.

**44** students entered the EPQ†, of whom **43%** achieved an A\* and **82%** A\*-A.

The overall pass rate at A level was **100%**.

**30%** of year 13 students achieved 3 or more A\*-A grades and **61%** of year 13 students achieved 3 or more A\* - B grades.

**36%** of year 13 students achieved at least AAB which includes two facilitating subjects.‡
