

Dear parents,

I hope you and your family are well, and that your daughter will be able to attend our face-to-face provision in school from next week, although I entirely understand that this may not be possible for some students. No student will be disadvantaged if they cannot attend.

Over the past two weeks we have been working on making the school safe for the larger number of students we expect to attend from now on. During face-to-face support, your daughter will be in one of our largest classrooms, in a group of no more than 15, with desks 2 metres apart. All classrooms have hand sanitiser, tissues and lidded bins, and these are available around the school.

Students will be briefed at the start of the day about how to stay safe, and the behaviour rules we expect them to follow. Please reinforce the importance of this with your child, and remind her that she must come straight home after school.

We have a one way system around our stairs and corridors to minimise contact, distanced tables in our refreshment areas and staff supervision at all times. There will be packaged food available for purchase, and free for students in receipt of free school meals, and drinking water. We won't be using the finger imaging entry and payment systems to minimise contact with hard surfaces, doors will be kept open for the same reason and we have significantly increased our cleaning schedule.

Your daughter will have face-to-face support from subject teachers. These will not always be the teachers they had before lockdown, but they will be GCSE subject teachers and able to provide reinforcement of learning and answers to questions students may have. Teachers will not present new learning, but will consolidate and revisit material students have covered.

We understand that this is a big step for young people to take after learning at home for so long. Teachers will make time in the sessions to reassure students, listen to their concerns, and allow and encourage them to interact with each other. Our concern is very much student welfare, and there will be colleagues on hand to help any student who is struggling in any way.

I've included the schedule below, and your daughter will be able to see her own sessions on Google Classroom. Please contact Ms Alvarado if you have any questions or concerns.

### **Year 10 face-to-face support -timetable for students and parents**

Online education will continue to be the main form of education at this time. The timetable below provides face-to-face subject specialist support to supplement the online learning.

Students **must** arrive at school for **9.20am** for a briefing in the main hall.

There will be three sessions of teaching:

Session 1: 9.30-10.30am

Session 2: 10.30-11.30am

Supervised break: 11.30am-12.00pm

Session 3: 12.00-1.00pm

There will be approximately 30 Year 10 students in school on each day. The day will finish at 1.00pm.

For the core groups, students will be split into working groups of 10. They will each have a session of English, maths and science. The groups will work in the same classroom for all of the sessions.

The core groups are based on maths classes. Students must carefully note their core group:

**CORE GROUP A = Ms Moran's and Mr Savoia's class**

**CORE GROUP B = Mr Low's class**

**CORE GROUP C = Ms Al-Zeer's class**

**CORE GROUP D = Ms Ghorbannejad's class**

Option subjects will be taught in groups of no more than 15. This will mean that for some subjects the group will be divided into two. The groups will work in the same classroom for all of the sessions.

It won't be possible for all students to necessarily see their usual subject teacher for every session, however they will all receive subject specialist teaching and support.
