

Covid-19 Testing in Schools: Privacy Notice

Covid-19 Testing at school and pupils results

We are working to keep our school as safe as possible. Following government advice, our school will be carrying out Covid-19 testing on pupils and staff.

A team of staff from Camden Council will be testing staff and pupils who want to participate on a weekly basis. The testing programme will help pupils to stay in education, by enabling close contacts of someone who tests positive to stay in school if they do a daily test for seven days.

In order for the school to plan and take the necessary steps to keep everyone safe, we would like to be informed of pupils' test results. The types of data we may collect are:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Year group/Class
- Positive/Negative result

We need consent to collect your test results data in accordance with data protection regulations. The lawful basis for processing your personal information for this purpose and according to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is Article 6(1)(a) - Consent: the individual has given clear consent to process their personal data for a specific purpose and Article 9(2)(a) – Explicit Consent: The individual has given explicit consent to the processing of those personal data for one or more specified purposes.

Pupils can provide consent themselves if aged 13 and above. A parent/guardian will need to provide consent if aged 11 or 12.

Consent will be recorded using a form which the school will provide.
